¹ History, Geography & RE will set prep for Third Form when appropriate according to their own timetable, with pupils being informed of these times at the start of the academic year.

College guidelines for prep by year group:

- 1st Form = 20 mins per subject per night
- 2nd Form = 30 mins per subject per night
- 3rd Form = 30 mins per subject per night

No prep will be set for 1st Form in first week of the new academic year.

Music, DT and Art may occasionally set prep according to the stage they are at in the curriculum.

This timetable indicates the day prep will be set, with prep to be completed in the next available prep time. Prep deadlines will allow preps to be staggered through the week; groups set more than two preps on a given day won't be expected to complete all subject preps for the following day.

On an Exeat weekend Saturday preps may be set in the previous lesson for that subject.

College holidays: Prep will not routinely be set for Junior School pupils over holiday time, although pupils may be encouraged to use this time to catch up missed work, review work already completed in a subject or to prepare for internal exams.
